SNA Responds to School Meal Flexibilities Complaints

In a statement issued in April, SNA expressed its support for the December 2018 final rule on school meal flexibilities in response to lawsuits filed in New York and Maryland challenging U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) actions. "SNA appreciates USDA's efforts to preserve strong standards to benefit students while addressing long-standing challenges to ensure they choose and consume healthy school meals," said SNA President Gay Anderson, SNS. The statement noted that the final rule aligns with the Institute of Medicine's (IOM) scientific recommendations for updating school meal nutrition standards. You can read the full statement here.
